

DON'T ADVERTISE YR PHONE 2 THIEVES

If your phone is stolen, it's bad enough that it's expensive to replace, but there is also the hassle of losing personal numbers, messages, pictures and downloads. So protect your phone!

BE AWARE

of those around you – if you are chatting on your phone keep an eye out for what's going on around you. Don't walk and text.

DON'T

leave your phone on tables in pubs, clubs or restaurants.

AVOID

using your phone near train or tube stations or when getting on or off a bus. Wait until you are further away from the stop or station.

ALWAYS

ask yourself "is it safe to use my phone now?" Your phone is valuable.
DON'T GIVE THIEVES THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE YOUR PHONE.

REGISTER – You can REGISTER your phone for free on www.immobilise.com. This will allow the police to return your phone to you if it gets stolen. You can also register your phone details with your network provider.

REPORT – If your phone gets lost or stolen, REPORT it immediately to the police and your network provider so they can block it from further use. For help on reporting it to your network provider you can call the **Immobilise helpline** on **08701 123 123**.

REUNITE – We're cracking down hard on mobile phone thieves. This means we're more likely to recover your phone if it's stolen. If we do, and you've registered on immobilise.com, we can REUNITE you with your phone and all the valuable information it holds.
